Please come join us for our second Education Dialogue. In December we want to bring together a diverse group – half students and half others, and we're aiming for 30% people of color. We will explore the question of "*How can we form an educational system that creates good people where everyone belongs?*" through stories of our own experiences. We will be using an approach called StoryBridge that we used successfully in mid-November to explore our Innovation Stories.

At this gathering, where we expect 30-40 people, we will plan a larger, longer intergenerational exploration of this question in February. We'll be video-recording the dialogue with easy opt-outs for people who prefer not to be taped. Video will be used for a program on CMTV as well as a 5-10 minute clip for invitation to the larger program in February.

League of Education Voters (LEV), Community Minded TV (CMTV), and Alliance for Innovative Education Redesign (AIER) are the organizations that have initiated this inquiry. They know we need to be looking deeply into questions about how our schools can help our kids meet the challenges and opportunities of the 21st Century.
